Sharks have sharp, flat teeth. A	The fossil tooth is sharp. B
Sharks eat fish, seals, and other ocean animals. C	Mountain lions have side teeth that are between 3 and 5 centimeters long. D
The fossil tooth is 5 centimeters long. E	Mountain lions have sharp teeth. F
Sharks have teeth that are between 1 and 5 centimeters long. G	The fossil tooth was found in sandstone, which is sedimentary rock made of layers. H
Other land animal fossils have been found nearby. I	The sandstone around this fossil tooth also has many fossil shells from ocean organisms. J
The fossil tooth was found in the mountains of Utah, an area where mountain lions live now. K	The fossil tooth is much flatter than a mountain lion's tooth. L
